Tests will be ridden in a 20x60 ring, followed by tests in a 20x40 ring

Rules, Regulations, and General Information

ABOUT THE KRC TEST FEST (PERCENTAGE DAYS)

1. Test Fest is not a competition. It's a chance to experience an encouraging "show" atmosphere and further your dressage skills. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to participate.
2. The objective is to raise your percentages after the judge's feedback. You may opt to re-ride the same test or another test (up to a maximum of 4 rides per equine-rider combination).
3. Each scheduled test allows for the test riding, plus additional time for live feedback from the judge.
4. Tests will be scored.

IMPORTANT

CLOSING DATES: One week before the percentage day or when all time slots are full.

To avoid disappointment, submit your entry early! Waiting lists will be prioritized by entry receipt and deposit. Entries must be complete with all accompanying information (see checklist). Email confirmation will be sent upon entry. Incomplete entries or those without confirmed/cleared payment will NOT be processed!

RIDE TIMES: Posted on the KRC Facebook page the evening of the Wednesday before Test Fest starts. Times will also be emailed to the address provided on the entry form. Please ensure your email is legible. Ride Times will additionally be posted at the Clubhouse on the porch bulletin board the day prior to Test Fest.

Thank you for choosing to participate in KRC's Test Fest! Your support is appreciated.

GENERAL INFORMATION & ARRIVALS WARM-UP ETIQUETTE

- Participants are welcome to arrive in advance of Test Fest. Stabling is available for day use or overnight. KRC charges a standard stabling fee, additional nights needed can be added to your entry form.
- If you need any last-minute prep items, complimentary bobby pins, spray deodorant, and hair spray are available in the Clubhouse washrooms. Please use only what you need and be considerate of others.
- KRC has an event parking/camping map. It is attached to this document, as well posted on the club grounds. Please follow the indicated flow of traffic for vehicles and trailers.
- Please be respectful of any areas flagged off on the grounds – do not move flagging in order to park.
- Check with the office to confirm trailer parking. Haul-ins must park in the indicated Day-use/Haul-in area if you plan to keep your horse tied to the trailer. Empty trailers and those camping on-site will likely be parked along the Jumper ring rail, this may be subject to change and participants will be notified via email prior to arrival in the ride times email.

WARM-UP ETIQUETTE

- No warming up in the Jumper ring. Warmups will be in Hunter ring and Dressage ring.
- Please do not block the entrance to the warm-up area.
- If you need to adjust tack, etc., please do so outside of the warm-up area.
- Pass left to left.
- Slower-moving riders (e.g., walking) should stay to the inside of the ring. Canter and trotting riders have the track.
- As a courtesy, inform other riders when you are passing and provide as much space as possible.
- If your equine is prone to kicking, place a RED ribbon in its tail. Riders, please be aware.
- If riding a stallion, place a BLUE ribbon in its tail.
- When using a headset, wear only one earbud to remain aware of your surroundings.
- Clucking or voice cues across the warm-up ring may disrupt other equines. It's best to stay ringside and cue the rider as they pass.
- If planning to serpentine, zigzag, or circle in an unusual spot, announce your intentions to alert others.
- Not all equines may have seen strollers, umbrellas, or humans in rain ponchos, or be comfortable around dogs ringside. Always approach the warm-up area with caution.
- The warm-up ring is intended for those about to enter their classes. Priority will be given to these riders if the warm-up ring has more than six equines.

ABUSE

Abuse of the horse is strictly forbidden. Abuse includes but is not restricted to: excessive use of spurs, abuse of the whip, and brutal use of the reins during halts or reinbacks, repeated tugs on the horse's mouth (EC Section A, General Rules 517).

SAFE SPORT COMPLIANCE

KRC adheres to Safe Sport standards to ensure a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all participants, particularly youth and vulnerable individuals. Our club promotes the principles of fair play, mutual respect, and ethical conduct, aligning with national and international Safe Sport guidelines. Any behavior that violates Safe Sport guidelines will be reported to the appropriate authorities and dealt with according to the policies in place.

PETS

Dogs at KRC must be well-behaved and under your direct control on a leash **at all times**.

SMOKING

Smoking/vaping is not allowed on KRC grounds, including any buildings, stabling areas, show office, or in competition and warm-up areas.

MEDIA RELEASE STATEMENT

By entering the grounds of Kelowna Riding Club [KRC], participants, spectators, and visitors acknowledge that photographs, video, or other recordings may be taken for promotional, educational, or archival purposes. [KRC] and its representatives have the irrevocable right to use such media, including images, video, and audio, in publications, social media, marketing materials, press releases, and other promotional content without compensation or restriction. If an individual does not wish to be recorded or photographed, they must notify [KRC] in writing prior to their participation in any activities.

SCHOOLING & LONGEING

- Schooling is not permitted within a competition ring unless specifically authorized.
- Longeing is permitted only in the lunge ring up to 30 minutes prior to the start of Test Fest. Longeing in the round pen is permitted throughout the day, from 7:00am to dusk.
- Under no circumstances is lunging permitted in warm-up/show areas.

NON-COMPETING EQUINES

- Non-competing equines (NCE) are subject to all the same rules as competing equines (an entry form must be submitted).
- There will be no entry or office fees for NCEs.
- NCEs must provide proof of vaccinations and HCBC coverage, as well as liability coverage (in the event of a riding/commercial stable).
- Stabling for an NCE will only be approved after all competing equines are accommodated.

INSURANCE

All owners or competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents, trainers, or their equines.

All participants **MUST** have current HCBC and a completed waiver on file in order to participate. Horse handlers also need to have current HCBC while on KRC grounds for insurance and liability requirements.

HEADGEAR

All riders must wear properly fitted and fastened safety-approved headgear when mounted.

EMERGENCY PLAN/EVACUATION

- In the event of an emergency, the show office will contact 911.
- KRC's emergency route map is posted at the Clubhouse and the ends of the barns in the event evacuation is required, and if normal exits from the club are blocked.
- In event of an emergency please follow directions from volunteers (dismount and make way for emergency vehicles).
- In the event of an evacuation, follow instructions from the announcer and volunteers.

FOOD/CONCESSION

There will be a concession on-site from 8:00am – 4:00pm Saturday and 8:00am – 2:00pm Sunday. Payment processed via Square Terminal – please bring a debit card or credit card. There will be no cash on-site.

Complimentary coffee and hot water for tea provided in the Clubhouse on Saturday and Sunday from morning until 12:00pm.

There's also a Subway, Dominos Pizza and J-Wok Express Chinese Takeout across the street. The Clubhouse has a fridge available on the porch for participants to use, if desired. KRC is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items placed in the fridge.

Please do not put ice boots in the freezer.

ENTRY INFORMATION

This event will be run under current HCBC rules

CLASS FEES per test (plus GST)

\$35 for KRC Members. \$40 for Guests.

GENERAL FEES (plus GST)

Administrative Fee (mandatory) \$15 for KRC Members. \$25 for Guests. Applies once per entry, not per test.

STABLING (plus GST)

Day Fee \$20 for KRC Members. \$30 for Guests.

Overnight Fee \$30 for KRC Members. \$40 for Guests.

Stall deposits of \$50 paid cash or cheque at the show office. Stalls must be stripped clean at the end of the show and deposit will be reimbursed.

RIDE TIMES SCHEDULE

If you wish to ride your tests immediately one after another (back-to-back), please indicate this on the show form. We will try to accommodate ride time requests whenever possible.

Note: 20 x 40 ring size tests will be scheduled at the end.

TESTS & RESULTS

Tests with scores and comments can be picked up at the show office

PRIZES

Test Fest ribbons for pick up in the Clubhouse/Show Office.

Ribbons are placed according to scores above

1st place > 65.0%

2nd place 61% to 64.9%

3rd place 59.0% to 60.9%

Ribbon Return Program – those who opt to return their ribbons during the show will receive an entry per ribbon into a gift basket draw to take place on Sunday, 30minutes after the last class ends. Winner must be on-site to receive gift basket or draw will continue until a winner who is present is drawn.

BIOSECURITY Kelowna Riding Club committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for all exhibitors and their horses. All participants are requested to practice good disease prevention practices. All horses entering the show grounds must not have been in contact with any sick horses within the last 15 days. Any horse that has been sick or exposed to an infectious disease within the last 15 days must have their attending veterinarian contact KRC prior to entry to the show grounds. We ask that any horse with a rectal temperature above 38.5 C (101.8 F) be reported to show management. Any horse identified to have or is suspected of having a contagious disease will be removed to the isolation area. Please avoid any direct or indirect contact between horses, in particular nose to nose contact and use of any common feed/drinking buckets. The early detection of any contagious disease is the key to prevention of a disease outbreak. We appreciate your cooperation and look forward to everyone having a successful horse show experience.

ATTIRE

DRESS

- Rider and equine should be neatly presented in the confines of the arena.
- Black or tan smooth leather half-chaps are permissible, provided they match the boot colour.
- No sweaters, t-shirts, tank tops, or other similar dress will be permitted
- Brushing boots and bandages may be worn.
- Tie-downs and martingales are not permitted.
- Headsets: Coaching headsets allowed. (check with judges) personally I would not allow
- Bits and general tack rules will mirror those of the governing body (e.g., Equestrian Canada, Pony Club, Working Equitation, etc.).

TEST CALLERS

- Permitted for ALL tests, including FEI.
- Should be neatly attired.
- To stand behind B or E.
- May call a movement a maximum of twice. NO additional comments or coaching.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

VACCINATIONS

All equines attending KRC events must provide proof of Equine Influenza and Equine Herpes Virus (1 and 4) vaccinations within six (6) months (+21 days grace period) before arrival at KRC. No equine shall have received vaccination within seven (7) days prior to arrival.

Proof of vaccination MUST be provided with entry form (copy of vet receipt showing equine's name and date of administration) or vaccination certificate or FEI vaccine passport page.

HCBC MEMBERSHIP

Proof of Horse Council of British Columbia's membership for the current year is required to be submitted with the entry for both equine owner and rider.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Parents, riders, coaches and friends are welcome to take their own amateur photographs.

HOW TO ENTER

YOUR TESTS

Equestrian Canada (EC) has adopted the United States Dressage Federation (USDF) and United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) dressage tests for levels from Introductory through Fourth Level, as well as Developing Horse and Freestyle tests. These tests became effective in January 2023 and will remain in use through 2026. These are the tests that will be judged.

Provide as much detail as possible on the entry form regarding the name, test level, and number. (Example: Equestrian Canada 2023 Fourth Level Test 3). Don't forget to specify the ring size.

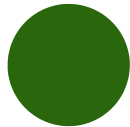
