Subject: Opposition to the Proposed 37m Monopole Tower at 3750 Casorso Road (File No. BC109554)

To Whom It May Concern,

As a concerned member of the Kelowna Riding Club, I am writing to strongly oppose the proposed 37-meter monopole tower at 3750 Casorso Road, referenced by file number BC109554.

The intended location for this tower is within a densely populated area, which would profoundly and negatively impact our property's use. The presence of such a tower would disrupt the tranquil and open environment essential for our equestrian activities and events.

Our club serves as a critical hub for community recreation, competition, and social engagement. The construction and existence of a large monopole tower in close proximity would likely dissuade members and visitors from participating in our events due to aesthetic concerns and potential health risks. This, in turn, could reduce membership and participation, severely affecting the club's sustainability and the benefits it provides to the local community.

We strongly urge the City of Kelowna and Telus Communications to explore alternative locations for this tower, ideally in areas that are less populated and do not interfere with established community organizations such as ours. It is essential that such projects consider the needs and objections of the communities they impact.

Thank you for addressing this critical issue. We trust that our concerns will be given the consideration they deserve and that a more appropriate location for the tower will be identified.
